Detailed Narrative:

Accompanied by Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development (MLITSD) inspector Robin Taylor.



This visit took place in the workplace and the following people were spoken to:

- Vanshika Sharma - Health and Safety Specialist
- Bev Biggs - JHSC Worker Member
- Steven Sloan - Occupational Health and Safety Manager

The reason for this visit was to assess compliance with the OHSA and applicable regulations.

Physical Inspection Findings:

- Observed boxes stored under the desk in the N.5.774 room in a manner that presented a hazard to workers that use the workstation. ORDER ISSUED.
- Observed 4 fume hoods in the N.5.774-A room. Discussed maintenance programs in place for the fume hoods. The employer stated that a third party inspection takes place semi annually.
- Observed several phlebotomy chairs in the hallway surrounding the N.5.883 room stored in a manner that presented a hazard to workers. ORDER ISSUED.
- Observed damage to the countertop in the N.5.757 room. ORDER ISSUED.
- Observed cables and boxes on the floor of the N.5.763 room stored in a manner that presented a hazard of tripping/falling to workers ORDER ISSUED.
- At the time of the inspection there was no handle installed on the lower cabinet of the N.5.421 room. ORDER ISSUED.
- Observed damage to the floor mounted desk at the 5th floor Oncology nurse station. ORDER ISSUED.
- Observed damage to the microwave stand in the N.5.023 break room. ORDER ISSUED.
- Observed a shelving unit in the N.5.023 room that was not secured against tipping/falling. ORDER ISSUED. The employer agreed to ensure that this unit is secured against tipping/falling before items are stored on this shelf.
- At the time of the inspection there were several sections of the 5th floor Respiriology nurse station desk that

-At the time of the inspection a puncture resistant container for sharps was not available to workers in the N.5.044 room although needles were handled and stored in this area. ORDER ISSUED.

-Observed several holes in the wall of the N.5.045 room. ORDER ISSUED.

This inspector will return at a later date to continue the inspection of this workplace.
