Nurses at Southwestern Public Health (SWPH) are fighting for **fair wages and respect in the workplace.**

What do our public health nurses do?

- Serve 200,000+ residents in **Oxford County, Elgin County and the City of St. Thomas.**
- Provide clinics, health services, health policy, outbreak management and home visits for **children, families and older adults.**
- Keep communities, workplaces, schools and health-care settings **strong and healthy.**

While paying nurses rock bottom wages, SWPH:

- **Withheld money** that could have been spent on front line nurses.
- Increased the **CEO's salary by 45.4 per cent**, compared to nurses who got a 7.4 per cent increase over 5 years.
- Continues to **disrespect** nurses despite the high-quality care they provide.
