





## **Stop Privatization and Support Staffing Ratios**

## To the Legislative Assembly of Ontario

WHEREAS understaffing is negatively impacting the quality of our public health-care system, causing longer wait times, unreliable access to care, unmanageable workloads, deskilling of health-care work, and many more issues.

WHEREAS understaffing causes burnout for nurses and health-care professionals, which is driving them out of the profession.

WHEREAS nurse and health-care professional staffing ratios will restore our public health care and ensure quality care across the system – including home care, long-term care, public health, and hospitals.

WHEREAS the Ford government has undermined the public health-care system by taking money that should be used on staffing to

instead make deals with private, for-profit corporations to deliver health care.

WHEREAS nurse vacancies and burnout decreased in other jurisdictions following the implementation of ratios and improved nurse and health-care professional retention.

## THEREFORE, we, the undersigned, petition the Legislative Assembly of Ontario as follows

Mandate staffing ratios for nurses and health-care professionals across the Ontario health-care system. Develop staffing ratios in consultation with nurses and health-care professionals through their unions. Use health-care funding to ensure that Ontarians can access the care they need within the public system, rather than privatizing health care through outsourcing services to private, for-profit corporations.
