Primary care workers at North York Family Health Team (NYFHT) have been **on strike since October 20**, fighting for a fair first-ever collective agreement so they can keep providing the care our community needs.

How does this impact North York families?

- NYFHT workers help support 95,000+ patients and keep our community healthy.
- They help provide comprehensive care for people at all stages of life from mental and physical health to chronic disease management.
- Without **fair wages and job security**, they cannot afford to keep working in primary care in North York.

It's time to **close the gap** in wages for primary care workers compared to other health-care settings so they can continue to provide high quality primary care to their North York patients.



North York Family Health Team: Give Striking Workers a Fair Contract Now

Fair wages and better working conditions for primary care workers at NYFHT means better care for people in North York.

The employer received additional government funding earlier this year for retention and recruitment, including for a wage increases, but is using it to make up for their own financial mismanagement instead.
