Did you know?

- In 2024, nine out of 10 nurses experienced some form of abuse in the previous year, including physical, verbal, sexual and emotional abuse.
- Between 2021-2024, health-care workers missed 130,438 days of work due to workplace violence and harassment.
- In 2024, emergency rooms across Ontario closed for a total of 14,980 hours, mostly due to understaffing.
- Other first responders like police and firefighters have staffing ratios.
- Staffing ratios are linked to higher retention rates, workplace satisfaction and safety for patients and staff.
